US Army Corps of Engineers "Stoplog" Boat

This is the Fourth in a series of four Springer Class model boats. This one was built for my son Mike, and is based on a real truckable pus boat built for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. It is located at the Little Goose Dam on the Snake River in Washington State. It serves as a workboat for the stoplog facility at the dam's lock.

This model hull, "Springer #4", was originally started on November 30, 2020 and is currently being worked on. The delay was because of no decision on what real boat it would replicate.

Springer #4 originated from a Zippkits "Tugster" kit. Everything from the deck on up is scratch built. Only the hull, shaft, propeller, and rudder were from the original kit, and even at that, some of it was modified.
